RULES

Men hit from the white tees; Women hit from the red tees; Senior hit from the gold tees;
Kids hit from the gold tees 12 and under

1st place payout is for 1st place; Next 3 spots will pay out by random draw

Mulligans are \$5.00 ea – one per nine; Play the ball up everywhere within one club length, except Hazards NO nearer the hole.

All fences are out of bounds-stroke and distance (go back to where ball was originally played);

Lost ball-stroke and distance (go back to where ball was originally played)

Water hazard on #8, #10, #11, #16, #17, and #18 one stroke penalties and make correct drop.

If you have a question about a ruling, play a second ball. Record both scores and a ruling will be made at the conclusion of round. Drop off all roads and cart paths. Nearest relief, no nearer to the hole

Longest Drive on Hole #2 - \$50.00 Prize (all players wanting to compete for this prize must drive from the white tee); Closest to the Pin on Hole #4 - \$50.00 Prize; Longest Putt (minimum 50ft) at the putting green by the Clubhouse \$5,000.00 Putter for the Longest Putt contest will be the winner of the chipping contest.

Every par 3 has a hole in one prize possibility- Witnesses are only needed on the truck hole. If you make a hole in one on the other holes call the Clubhouse and report it immediately

Chipping contest- \$5 dollars per shot or 5 shots for \$20 winner will take ½ of the pot and get the chance to putt for \$5,000. If more than one person makes the shot then there will be a shoot out unless an agreement is reached by the people who tie.
